I know you pray for the students and their families often. Just the other day, I was able to go through the entire plan of salvation with one of our students. Job did not accept Christ that day, but the Gospel seed was planted. We hope that he will soon accept Christ as his per-

Zambia is one of the countries that rank high for Covid currently. Our mothers of children 3 and under must stay home for now. We have been visiting them and keeping in touch by phone. We long for the day that they can return to our services. Other than this group of people, most of our members have returned back to church. The pews and Sunday School classes are filling up, we have had salvations, discipleship and baptisms. Our visitation is well attended and our Wednesday night prayer meetings are growing. We praise the Lord that our church continues to grow.

Over the last few months, my Sunday School girls have been studying the Armor of God. Most of my class have memorized Ephesians 6:10-24. What a delight these girls are to me! They challenge my walk with the Lord, as I teach them in their personal walk. Recently, one of the girls has been struggling with lying and deceit (which in the Zambian culture is not considered a sin, unless you are caught). I was able to take her to the Armor of God passage and we spoke about how satan has access to the deceitfulness of your heart, when you do not have on the breastplate of righteousness. I pray that she will see her sin as God sees it and not be fooled by the cultural acceptance of it.

There is so much to share, but little space to share it. Just a reminder that I am in the States on furlough from now until the end of August.
