- ▶ **Sandra-** **Sandra** made a profession of faith nearly a year ago. Initially, she showed interest in the things of God and was involved in a weekly discipleship course with Amanda. However, it seems as if the call of the world has drawn her away a bit at the moment. Her and her sister **Liza** (unsaved) used to attend every evening service. **Please pray for these two sisters.**



Homeless Outreach

In February, we started our *Backpack Ministry* for the homeless in the area. Over the course of a month, we stuff a backpack full of things homeless people need, then go in the town centre in search of someone to bless. The people in the church have really taken to this ministry.

Gratefully, we've already had two "success" stories in relation to this ministry. After meeting **Dave** on the streets, we've helped Dave get job and apartment. **Peter** was a homeless man who knocked on the Church door one evening asking for help. We gave him a backpack and directed him to the council building, where he has since found housing and has put in several job applications. We were blessed to help these two men physically and economically, but **please pray for the salvation of their souls.**
