Thankfully, that has now changed! In April, a group of four came from the Mt. Zion Baptist Church of Denver, PA to knock out some walls and remodel our "auditorium." This group came to work, and did they ever work! They worked long hours and transformed our once tiny cramped room into a beautiful place to worship the LORD. Our seating capacity has been doubled. We pray now that we can fill every seat!
